Accommodation Overview

Congratulations on your decision to come and study IT in New Zealand. Now that you've made your choice, the next step is to find somewhere to live when you arrive.

New Zealand Immigration service (NZIS) require all international students to have some form of accommodation confirmed BEFORE they arrive in the country. This is so that you do not feel lost and alone. You don't have to stay in this accommodation forever but it's a good start to your time in New Zealand.

There are three options open to you to research further and enquire

1. **Privately Arranged** - You have got friends or family living in Auckland and they are going to arrange everything for you GREAT! However please remember to advise our admissions staff at Computer Power Institute before you arrive and complete the PRIVATELY ARRANGED ACCOMMODATION FORM.
2. **Homestay** - This is where you live with a New Zealand family in their home and this is a great way to get to know what we are like. You will experience our style of cooking and enjoy our types of sporting and recreational activities. This can only be reserved for a minimum of the four weeks initially - once reserved and paid for, there are no refunds. After four weeks, you may meet friends and decide to move out on your own or you can extend your homestay longer on a fortnightly basis. PLEASE COMPLETE THE HOMESTAY APPLICATION FORM
3. **Temporary Accommodation** - This can include shared or private backpacker, hostel or budget hotel accommodation and usually booked for 2 - 7 nights. This gives you time to settle in to your new surroundings and gives you time to find the accommodation that's just right for you. PLEASE COMPLETE THE HOTEL/HOSTEL APPLICATION FORM.

2. Homestay Accommodation

Homestay is valuable in providing the student with an insight to the Kiwi way of life and the overall success of the students New Zealand experience. The home stay environment has many advantages and is the preferred option for students coming to New Zealand to learn English. While in homestay care, we want the student to become a member of the family and integrate into their lifestyle, joining in with the day to day routines.

Homestay families will provide you with a separate fully furnished bedroom, a comfortable bed, wardrobe, drawers, desk, chair, reading light and heater. They provide breakfast and dinner each day through the week and three main meals on weekends.

Additionally, they provide fresh linen and towels regularly and help the students do their laundry. Some families may provide you with one set of house keys to enable convenient access.

Homestay homes are within 10 minutes walk to public transport and usually situated in the outer suburbs with varying transport times of 15 - 45 minutes.

3. Temporary Accommodation - Budget Hotels/Hostels

Offers affordable accommodation in the heart of New Zealand's largest city. All of the city's major attractions are within walking distance, including the Viaduct Basin and the CBD.

The early 20th century building is a versatile Hotel, well suited to the budget conscious traveller. Fully equipped Hotel Business rooms are available, single, double or twin. Each room has a TV, clock radio, tea and coffee making facilities, hair dryer and ensuite bathrooms have a shower. Two lifts service these rooms.
